*A perfect project for beginners, you will learn about the basics of embroidery and essential stitches while producing a Needlebook.*

While creating this project we will master the most basic surface stitches: Running; Stem; Outline; Cable; Back; Satin; French & Colonial Knots; Bullions; Cross; Herringbone; Couching; Feather; Chain; Lazy Daisy; and Buttonhole.

We will also discuss some of the basic embroidery techniques, such as: Transferring designs; Stabilising fabrics; Needle selection; Selecting, using, starting and finishing threads; using a Hoop; Pressing and Finishing techniques.

The Needlecase/book is an essential piece of equipment for all stitchers. This version features 6 pockets for storing packets of different types and sizes of needles as well as a wool pad for storing those needles that you are using. There is also a handy pocket for the simple stitch and needle guide provided and your scissors if you wish.
